DAY 1. MELBOURNE / SEOUL / VANCOUVER (meals on board plane.L.D)

Depart Melbourne, Tullamarine Airport for Seoul with Korea Airlines flight KE126 at 7:45 am. This flight should arrive into Seoul at around 5:55 pm (local time) for a connecting flight with Korea Airlines flight KE71 departing at 6:50 pm for Vancouver.

Hello Vancouver! After ground formalities, you will be met and transferred by coach for lunch and afterwards, transported to your accommodation point for a brief rest. In the evening, the group will head out for dinner and finally some more rest back at the hotel .

Accommodation: Four Point of Sheraton Hotel or similar (4 star)

DAY 2. VANCOUVER / VICTORIA ISLAND (B.L.D)

After breakfast, the group will head off for a whole day tour at Victoria Island. Your tour will start with a 90 minute Ferry ride to Victoria Island where you will experience the most exhilarating scenery with an ocean or mountain vista around every corner of the island which includes a visit to the famous Butchart Gardens! Return to Vancouver for dinner. After dinner, check back at hotel for rest.

DAY 3. VANCOUVER / KAMLOOPS / GOLDEN (B.L.D)

This morning, we head off to visit the rich farmland of Fraser Valley and then follow Coquihalla Highway through Fraser Canyon and Thompson River Valley where we then arrive at Kamloops for a brief rest and lunch stop. In the afternoon, we continue our journey eastbound, which will include a tour of Ginseng Farm and an orientation tour of Last Spike Historical Site, Three Valley Gap, Glacier National Park and Roger's Pass.

As thousands of gold-crazed adventurers sought the best starting point for their arduous trek, they found the deepest penetration possible was via boat at the northern tip of the Lynn Canal. This is how the town of Skagway was born. Overnight on cruise.

DAY 17. SEOUL (B.L.D)

Your overnight flight will arrive into Seoul at about 5:20 pm local time. After ground formalities, you will be met and transferred for dinner. For our overnight stay, we check in at Seoul Koreaana Hotel similar.

Accommodation: Seoul Koreaana Hotel or similar (5 star)

DAY 18 SEOUL (B.L.D)

Today we spend a whole day in Seoul which includes a visit to Kyeongbok Palace- built by Joseon Dynasty in 1394. Afterwards, the group will head off to the Presidential Blue House, the Namsangol Hanok Village, etc.. After a nice lunch, we then proceed to visit Insadong Street and Schichon Shopping area for some shopping retail therapy! In the evening, kick back and watch a show called " Nanta", a very popular modern musical performance in South Korea and other countries in Asia.

DAY 19. SEOUL / MELBOURNE (B.L.meals on board plane)

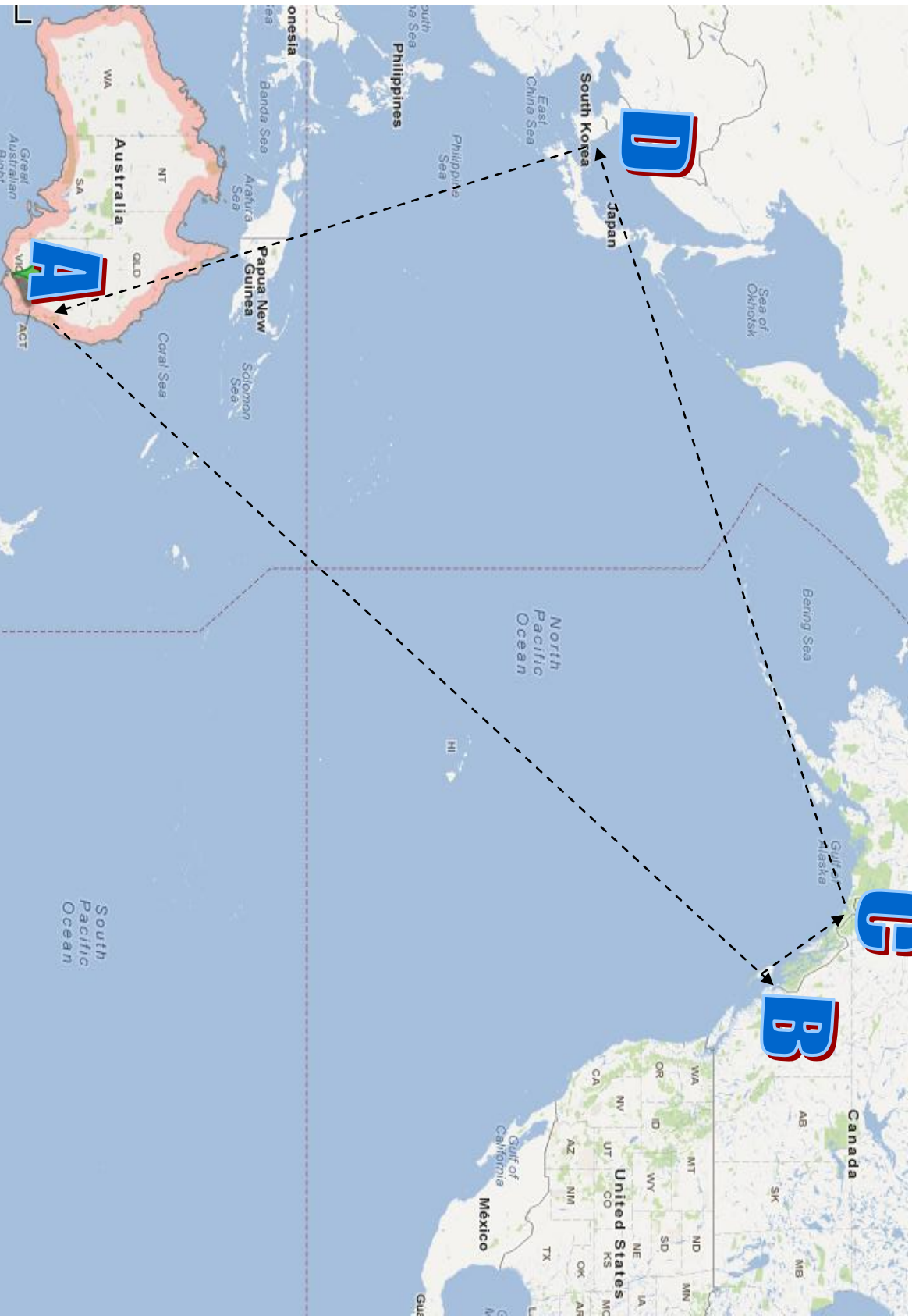

Booking Conditions

1. How to book

Reservations can only be confirmed upon receipt of a deposit of \$200 per person payable to Friendly Travel Service together with a completed and signed booking form and also subject to availability. As soon as the cruise cabin deposit has been confirmed, a further \$1200.00 deposit per/passenger will be required. The balance of payment must be received 45 days prior to departure. If the booking is made within 45 days of departure, then full payment is required immediately upon such booking is confirmed. If the booking is made by yourself and also acting on behalf of other persons, your signature will be taken as having accepted the booking conditions by all the persons concerned.

Late reservations may be accepted subject to availability. In some cases, a higher airfare may be incurred.

2. Cancellations

From the date of booking confirmation, a cancellation service fee of \$200.00 per/person plus cruise deposit will apply if you cancel your reservation for whatever reason. If cancellation is received:

Between 22 to 44 days before departure: - automatic forfeiture of 20% of total tour package plus airlines' cancellation fee, cruise payment and deposit payment.

Cancellation within 21 days of departure: - the whole tour cost. These fees are imposed by the relevant hotels, overseas operators and transportation companies.

All cancellations must be in writing.

3. Refunds

No refund whatsoever will be made on the accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours and transfers not taken during the period overseas.

4. Reservation and Check-in time

After tickets have been issued, no change is permitted to the outbound or inbound reservations. It is vitally important that you must observe the regulations regarding arrival time for your check-in procedure. Anyone who fails to observe these regulations and subsequently misses the scheduled departure time will bear all the additional expenses for any alternative arrangements made. Such alternative arrangements are subject to availability. Please remember to re-confirm your flight 72 hours before depart from overseas back to Australia.

5. Insurance

At the time of booking, insurance cover is strongly recommended and is available at a moderate premium. This cover may only be taken up between the time of booking and making balance of payment. Details are available at this office.

6. Travel documents (Australian citizens)

Each tour member must hold a valid passport as well as a visa for certain countries. Applications for passport may be made at the Passport Section of the Foreign Affairs Department of each capital city, or at your nearest Post Office.

Visa for some of the countries can be arranged by this office. Passengers are provided with one visa application form for completion and are asked to submit this, together with one recent passport-size photograph and your valid passport (must have 6 months validity from the date of entry) to this office by the due date required if you want us to apply for you. A visa fee (Depends on the fee charged by the country that you visit) will be collected by this office on behalf of the passenger in order to apply for the visa required. Some of the country's visa application forms are available from our office. Please check with our office for updated information.

7. Health requirements

As a precaution we advise that you check with your family doctor. It is advisable that you obtain a copy of the doctors certificate indicating that you are fit to travel if you are over the age of 70.

8. Amendments

After tickets have been issued within 21 days of departure, no amendments to the flight schedules can be made. Any amendment to a confirmed tour booking must be made 45 days before departure and airlines' amendment fee will be applied for each amendment.

9. Tour arrangements overseas

Our tour operators overseas have the control over hotel accommodation, transportation, meals, sightseeing, etc., during the entire period there. These tour operators and their associate agents reserve the right to alter their arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances. When such an event does occur, Friendly Travel Service Pty. Ltd. shall bear no responsibility.

10. Single Room Supplement

Single room is available on request and a supplement will be required. However, this is only available if it does not create another single room for which no one is prepared to pay for the supplement. If this situation does occur, it is therefore necessary for them to share.

11. Responsibility

Friendly Travel Service Pty. Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the operator) and their agents act as agent only to the transportation services (airlines, coach companies, railroads, shipping companies), hotels and firms and shall not assume any responsibility for loss, damage, injury, accident, delay, changes in schedule, hotel overbooking or other inconvenience to the passenger whether by reason of defect in any vehicle or through acts of default of any company or person engaged in conveying or housing the passenger or in carrying out arrangements of the tour itself overseas or otherwise in connection therewith. The operator shall not assume responsibility in connection with any of the aforementioned services or through acts of war, national disturbances or causes of nature. The transportation companies, hotels and firms shall be exempt from all liability in respect of any detention, delay, loss, damage, sickness or injury however and by whom-so-ever caused and whatever kind occurring on or to the passenger at any time when the passenger is not on board a carrier or conveyance used or operated by the transportation companies or hotels. The operator, its associates or agents, while taking every care with the passengers' luggage or property, shall not accept any liability for damage, loss or inconvenience in the handling thereof. The Passage Contract in use by the transportation companies or firms concerned shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation companies or firms and purchasers of these arrangements and/or passengers.

12. Law of Contract

The Contract is governed by the Law of the State of Victoria and any legal action arising from there shall be litigated only in the appropriate court having jurisdiction in that State.

13. Disclaimer

Our operating airlines do not by virtue of their endorsements of this brochure represent themselves either as contracting with any purchaser of a holiday from Friendly Travel Service or as having any other legal relationship with any such purchase.
