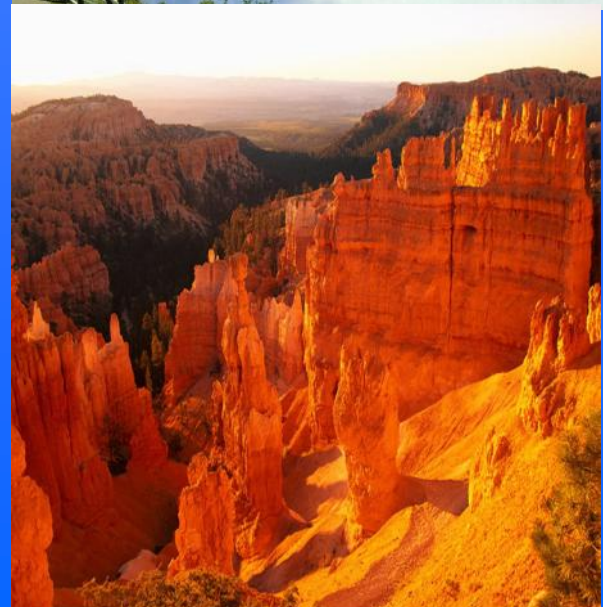
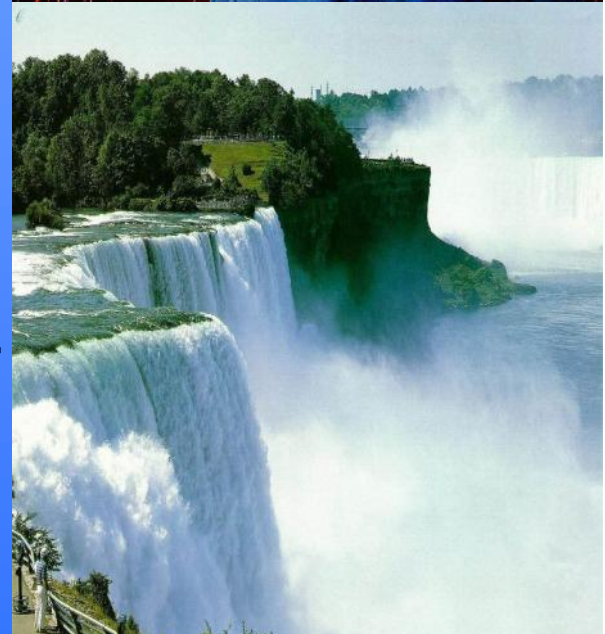

Itinerary

B = breakfast provided , L = lunch provided , D = dinner provided

DAY 1. MELBOURNE / NEW YORK via SEOUL

Depart Melbourne for New York via Seoul with Korean Airlines flight KE126 at 7:45 am for arrival into Seoul at approximately 5:55 pm. We then connect up with Korean Airlines flight KE85 at 7:30 pm bound for New York. After our scheduled arrival into New York at 8:40 pm, you will be met by our professional tour guide and transferred to hotel.

Accommodation: Marriott Saddle Brook Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar for overnight stay (meals on board plane)

DAY 2. NEW YORK

After breakfast, our tour guide will greet the group at hotel lobby for a full day New York city tour including Chinatown, Wall Street, Ground Zero, Times Square, Madam Tussaud's Wax Museum, United Nations, Rockefeller Centre, Fifth Avenue and the Empire State Building, etc. We then cruise on the New York River to see the Statue of Liberty to complete the sightseeing tour.

Accommodation: Marriott Saddle Brook Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)



DAY 3. NEW YORK / PHILADELPHIA / WASHINGTON DC

Soon after breakfast, proceed by coach to Philadelphia for visits to Independence Hall and Liberty Bell, etc. In the late afternoon we continue the journey to Washington DC.

Accommodation: Courtyard Gaithersburg Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAY 4. WASHINGTON DC

A whole day in Washington DC to visit Lincoln Memorial, Vietnam and Korea War Memorial, Air Space Museum, Capitol Hill and the White House, etc.

Accommodation: Courtyard Gaithersburg Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAY 5. WASHINGTON DC / NIAGARA FALLS / BUFFALO

After breakfast at the hotel, the group will head off via coach to visit Hershey's Chocolate World and Corning Glass Centre before arriving at Niagara Falls.

Accommodation: Adam's Mark Hotel (3 stars) or similar at Buffalo. (B.L.D)

Accommodation: Hotel Don Valley (4 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)



DAY 7. TORONTO / OTTAWA / MONTREAL

Today you will enjoy a boat cruise on Thousand Island, then proceed to visit Ottawa – the capital city of Canada! Enjoy a short tour of Parliaments Building, Centennial Flame, Peace Tower, The Monument, Embassy District and Rideau Canal, etc. Afterwards we continue our journey to Montreal which includes visits to St. Joseph Oratory.

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Midtown Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D).

DAY 8. MONTREAL / BOSTON

After having breakfast at the hotel, proceed by coach for a city tour in Montreal before travelling to Boston. En-route, you will also have a chance to visit one of the best **duty free shops** before crossing the border to Boston.

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Rockland Hotel (4 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAY 9. BOSTON / LOS ANGELES

After breakfast, we start off with a Boston City tour which include visits to Harvard University, MIT, Quincy Market and a Harbour cruise, etc. After completing all sightseeing tours in Boston, the group will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Los Angeles via American Airlines flight AA145 departing at 5:00 pm. Once we arrive into Los Angeles, we will be transferred to our accommodation.

Accommodation: Holiday Inn Buena Park Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L)

Accommodation: Harrah’s Hotel (4 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAY 13. LAS VEGAS / GRAND CANYON / LAS VEGAS

After breakfast at the hotel, we head off to visit Hoover Dam – one of the seven Wonders of the Industrial World. Then proceed to visit the Grand Canyon South Rim, etc.

Accommodation: Harrah’s Hotel (4 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAY 14. LAS VEGAS / FRESNO

This morning we visit Barstow for lunch and outlet shopping. Afterwards we head off to visit Fresno - the centre of California agriculture.

Accommodation: Radisson downtown hotel (3.5 stars) or similar (B.L.D)

DAY 15. FRESNO / SAN FRANCISCO

After breakfast we will visit Yosemite National Park to see the beautiful waterfalls and walk along trails among towering pine trees- be amazed of such beauty natural scenery.

Accommodation: Hilton Garden Hotel (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAY 16. SAN FRANCISCO

A whole day in San Francisco to visit Golden Gate Bridge, Fisherman's Wharf, Lombard Street, Palace of Fine Arts and Chinatown, etc.

DAY 17. SAN FRANCISCO / LOS ANGELES

Soon after breakfast, proceed by coach to visit highway 1 to enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Pacific Coast. Along the way, we pay visit to Solvang. This city is home to a number of bakeries, restaurants, and merchants offering a taste of Denmark in California.

Accommodation: Airtel Plazal (3.5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)

DAYS 18 LOS ANGELES / SEOUL

Today we head down to Hollywood Boulevard to see Mann's Chinese Theatre, Kodak Theatre and Music Center (where the Oscar Awards Ceremony are held). Then continue on to Universal Studios where you can see how many famous American movies and TV shows are made. After dinner we say goodbye to USA and head off to LAX airport for our flight to Seoul via Korean Airlines flight KE16 departing at 12:40am (B.D)



DAY 19. IN FLIGHT BOUND FOR SEOUL

Whilst in flight, sit back, relax and try to reflect on the good times you had enjoyed so far! (meals on board)

DAY 20. ARRIVE SEOUL

Your overnight flight arrives into Seoul at 5:45 am this morning and after ground formalities, you will be greeted met at the airport and transferred for a Seoul city tour, which includes a visit to Kyeongbok Palace – built by Joseon Dynasty in 1394. Afterwards, the group will head off to the President Blue House, the Namsnagol Hanok Village, etc. After a nice lunch, we then proceed to visit Insadong Street, Schichon Shopping area and Dongdaemun Market for some shopping retail therapy! In the evening, kick back and watch a show called “Nanta”, a very popular modern musical performance in South Korea and other countries in Asia. After the performance, we check into our hotel for some rest.

Accommodation: Seoul Koreana Hotel (5 stars) or similar. (B.L.D)



DAY 21. SEOUL/MELBOURNE

Soon after breakfast we visit an official Ginseng Factory Outlet – Koreans love this particular herbal root, which they believe is great for their health well-being. Afterwards, we say goodbye to Seoul where we will depart for our Korean Airlines flight KE125 at 6:10 pm for Melbourne. (B.L.meals on board)

DAY 22. HELLO MELBOURNE!

Your overnight flight will arrive Melbourne at around 6:05 am this morning, thus to conclude this wonderful and memorable journey!!!

Booking Conditions

1. How to book

Reservations can only be confirmed upon receipt of a deposit of \$200 per person payable to Friendly Travel Service together with a completed and signed booking form and are subject to availability. The balance of payment must be received 45 days prior to departure. If the booking is made within 45 days of departure, then full payment is required immediately upon such booking is confirmed. If the booking is made by yourself and also acting on behalf of other persons, your signature will be taken as having accepted the booking conditions by all the persons concerned.

Late reservations may be accepted subject to availability. In some cases, a higher airfare may be incurred.

2. Cancellations

From the date of booking confirmation, a cancellation service fee of \$200.00 will apply if you cancel your reservation for whatever reason. If cancellation is received:

Between 22 to 44 days before departure: - automatic forfeiture of 20% of total tour package plus airlines' cancellation fee and deposit payment.

Cancellation within 21 days of departure: - the whole tour cost. These fees are imposed by the relevant hotels, overseas operators and transportation companies.

All cancellations must be in writing.

3. Refunds

No refund whatsoever will be made on the accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours and transfers not taken during the period overseas.

4. Reservation and Check-in time

After tickets have been issued, no change is permitted to the outbound or inbound reservations. It is vitally important that you must observe the regulations regarding arrival time for your check-in procedure. Anyone who fails to observe these regulations and subsequently misses the scheduled departure time will bear all the additional expenses for any alternative arrangements made. Such alternative arrangements are subject to availability. Please remember to re-confirm your flight 72 hours before depart from overseas back to Australia.

5. Insurance

At the time of booking, insurance cover is strongly recommended and is available at a moderate premium. This cover may only be taken up between the time of booking and making balance of payment. Details are available at this office.

6. Travel documents (Australian citizens)

Each tour member must hold a valid passport as well as a visa for certain countries. Applications for passport may be made at the Passport Section of the Foreign Affairs Department of each capital city, or at your nearest Post Office.

Visa for some of the countries can be arranged by this office. Passengers are provided with one visa application form for completion and are asked to submit this, together with one recent passport-size photograph and your valid passport (must have 6 months validity from the date of entry) to this office by the due date required if you want us to apply for you. A visa fee (Depends on the fee charged by the country that you visit) will be collected by this office on behalf of the passenger in order to apply for the visa required. Some of the country's visa application forms are available from our office. Please check with our office for updated information.

7. Health requirements

As a precaution we advise that you check with your family doctor. It is advisable that you obtain a copy of the doctors certificate indicating that you are fit to travel if you are over the age of 70.

8. Amendments

After tickets have been issued within 21 days of departure, no amendments to the flight schedules can be made. Any amendment to a confirmed tour booking must be made 45 days before departure and airlines' amendment fee will be applied for each amendment.

9. Tour arrangements overseas

Our tour operators overseas have the control over hotel accommodation, transportation, meals, sightseeing, etc., during the entire period there. These tour operators and their associate agents reserve the right to alter their arrangements due to unforeseen circumstances.

When such an event does occur, Friendly Travel Service Pty. Ltd. shall bear no responsibility.

10. Single Room Supplement

Single room is available on request and a supplement will be required. However, this is only available if it does not create another single room for which no one is prepared to pay for the supplement. If this situation does occur, it is therefore necessary for them to share.

11. Responsibility

Friendly Travel Service Pty. Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the operator) and their agents act as agent only to the transportation services (airlines, coach companies, railroads, shipping companies), hotels and firms and shall not assume any responsibility for loss, damage, injury, accident, delay, changes in schedule, hotel overbooking or other inconvenience to the passenger whether by reason of defect in any vehicle or through acts of default of any company or person engaged in conveying or housing the passenger or in carrying out arrangements of the tour itself overseas or otherwise in connection therewith. The operator shall not assume responsibility in connection with any of the aforementioned services or through acts of war, national disturbances or causes of nature. The transportation companies, hotels and firms shall be exempt from all liability in respect of any detention, delay, loss, damage, sickness or injury however and by whom-so-ever caused and whatever kind occurring on or to the passenger at any time when the passenger is not on board a carrier or conveyance used or operated by the transportation companies or hotels. The operator, its associates or agents, while taking every care with the passengers' luggage or property, shall not accept any liability for damage, loss or inconvenience in the handling thereof. The Passage Contract in use by the transportation companies or firms concerned shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation companies or firms and purchasers of these arrangements and/or passengers.

12. Law of Contract

The Contract is governed by the Law of the State of Victoria and any legal action arising from there shall be litigated only in the appropriate court having jurisdiction in that State.

13. Disclaimer

Our operating airlines do not by virtue of their endorsements of this brochure represent themselves either as contracting with any purchaser of a holiday from Friendly Travel Service or as having any other legal relationship with any such purchase.
